

A young girl in the area Superior Law serves suffered a broken arm as a result of a trampoline accident at a friend's home, for which she had surgery at a regional hospital.. She was placed in a cast and treated for nearly a year.

The Attorney's and staff obtained a medical report outlining her physical condition from her primary surgeon to determine anticipated future treatment and permanency of her injury for her lifetime. In addition, additional medical records were received specifically related to her surgical procedure.

Superior Law's Private Investigator investigation revealed that responsibility was clear as to the owner of the trampoline with no fault of the young girl. The case was successful for the following reasons:

Superior Law represented her by pointing out responsibility to the insurance company as follows:

Claim Facts

- The young girl was just a child at the time of this accident.
- The child was picked up by her friend's relative and taken to the party.
- Although the parents gave permission for the child to attend the party, they were not aware of the existence of a trampoline at the friend's home.
- Multiple children were on the trampoline at the time of the accident.
- Another child landed on our client's arm resulting in her fractured arm.

FAULT

- The responsible party was at fault for allowing the visiting child on a trampoline. This was against the manufacturer's warning as well as a number of trampoline safety publications.
- The responsible party was negligent for allowing multiple other children on the trampoline at the same time. This is also against the manufacturer's instructions on proper use as well as a number of published trampoline safety recommendations.
- The responsible party was at fault for not properly supervising the users of the trampoline. It is obviously apparent that a young child was able to gain access to the trampoline along with multiple others at the same time.

Pain and suffering:

The Child was young when she underwent the injury and related treatment. Superior Law pointed out the fear and confusion of this child in undergoing x-rays, prodding and poking of the injured area and ultimately surgery under complete general anesthesia. Equally as painful is the fear the parents underwent as a result of seeing their daughter go through this ordeal. Because of the injury, our client was limited in her activities over the subsequent months of rehabilitation. That was difficult.. Finally, there is the unknown factor of whether or not there will be ulnar nerve damage as a result of the deformity in her right arm. To some degree, this injury will haunt this child for a lifetime.

Result

Superior Law was able to obtain a sizable monetary recovery for the child and her parents. Her medical bills were paid in full. As a result of Superior Law's Aggressive representation of the Family, the matter was resolved without going to Court.
